DAY CARE CENTRE

Specialist Care
in a *Joyful* Environment





At **Assisi Day Care Centre**, we provide a warm and interactive environment for patients who require palliative care during the day. Patients spend almost a full day with us, under the care of our multidisciplinary specialist team consisting of doctors, nurses, Psychosocial Support Team (Medical Social Workers/ Counsellors), Allied Health Professionals (Physiotherapists, Occupational Therapists, Music and Art Therapists, Speech Therapist), Clinical Pastoral Care Team, support staff and volunteers.

Guided by our mission of providing compassionate, personalised and quality palliative care, we seek to know the person with life-limiting conditions through understanding their strengths and discovering their values and interests.



WHO WE SERVE

We serve patients with life-limiting illnesses such as cancer and end stage organ failure, and who are well enough to engage in day care activities. We are one of the few centres well-equipped to support patients with lung diseases who require continuous use of oxygen.



WHAT WE PROVIDE



Specialist Medical Care

Our doctors and nurses work closely to manage symptoms due to life-limiting illnesses or chronic diseases, such as pain and breathlessness, so that patients can be as physically comfortable as possible.



Psychosocial and Clinical Pastoral Care

Our medical social workers offer emotional and psychosocial support for our patients and their family members. As we journey together with patients, we will also explore advance care planning with them.



Rehabilitation in Palliative Care

Through exercise and group therapy, our physiotherapists and occupational therapists optimise patients' mobility and independence in daily living. We also make home visits if home modifications are needed.



Interest groups

We embrace our patients' strengths and interests through interest groups such as hand chimes, cooking, gardening and Men's Shed (woodworks). Led by the occupational therapists, music and art therapists, these interest groups empower and build a sense of identity and belonging, enhancing our patients' quality of life.
